PROMOTE YOUR BUSINESS ON SOCIAL MEDIA

Social Media is a great way to promote your business and encourage more people to support you. As we adjust to a different way of life, Australians are incredibly supportive of those who have experienced challenges and are increasingly open to supporting businesses in order to protect local communities.

Research shows that more and more Australians are concerned about the transmission of Covid-19 in the community and ensuring that the local community services, that we all rely on, survive the pandemic. These are two important considerations for businesses to use to promote yourselves during this crisis.

Businesses should post on social media and:

- Promote the ways in which they have adapted during the pandemic.
 Example: A café shifting to takeaway and delivery
- Promote the ways in which your business is keeping patrons and shoppers safe from Covid-19.

Example: Social media posts on how you ensure that your business is Covid safe

 Reinforce the importance of your business to the community, through the services and support that you provide.

Example: Picture of local sporting clubs that are sponsored by your business
